



Peter ten Dijke received his Ph.D. degree in 1991 from Wageningen University, The Netherlands. He did his postgraduate studies with Kohei Miyazono and Carl-Henrik Heldin at the Ludwig Institute for Cancer Research (LICR), Uppsala, Sweden.

In 1994, he became group leader at LICR and in 1999 he moved to the Netherlands Cancer Institute, Amsterdam, The Netherlands.

In 2005 he moved to the LUMC, and is currently a professor of molecular cell biology at Leiden University.

His laboratory studies how subverted TGF family signaling is involved in vascular, cancer and bone diseases.
